

# Grand Rapids paint-out schedule with Nelia Harper

## May

- May 15 Veterans Memorial Park [10 NE 8th Ave](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Filled with long-lived white pine, woodlands, and river views. Meet just inside the park entrance by the first playground.
- May 22 Prairie River Trail at [Co Rd 61/Mesabi Trail](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Located across from Lower Prairie Lake. Take a short walk along the paved trail to an abandoned cabin, remnants of mining equipment, emerald green ponds, bridge, and river views. You can also cross the road to Lower Prairie Lake and Prairie River Dam. Meet in the parking lot. Overflow parking across the road.
- May 29 Grand Rapids Area Library [140 NE 2nd Street](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Located in the heart of downtown Grand Rapids along the Mississippi River. Enjoy the lush river or explore the urban setting with nearby dam, alleys, shops and paper mill. Meet in the parking lot.

## June

- June 5 [22994 Kolp Road](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Enjoy lake views, gardens, outbuildings, and woodland trails.
- June 12 Forest History Center, [2609 County Road 76](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Five miles of trails, including bog river, woods, horses, wildflowers, and re-created logging camp. Meet in the main parking lot.
- June 19 Gunn Park, [4680 Hwy 38](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Located on Prairie Lake, this park includes stands of pine, woodland, forest, walking trails, grassy areas, and lake views. Meet in the parking area near the pavilion.
- June 26 MN North College, [1851 Hwy 169](#), Grand Rapids, MN
  - Choose from barns, outbuildings, bog walk, cattle herds, birds, flower gardens and forest. After turning into the college, follow the roundabout to the second right-hand turn. Follow to the end and park at the U o M NCROC North Country Trail Parking Log.
